The Lowcountry Affiliate of Susan G. Komen for the Cure® is proud to announce the availability of grant funds for fiscal year 2010. Applications for breast cancer and breast health programs from nonprofit organizations, governmental agencies and educational institutions in Allendale, Bamberg, Barnwell, Beaufort, Berkeley, Charleston, Colleton, Dorchester, Georgetown, Hampton, Horry, Jasper, and Orangeburg counties are eligible for funding.

The promise of Susan G. Komen for the Cure® is to save lives and end breast cancer forever by empowering people, ensuring quality care for everyone and energizing science to find the cure. The Organization runs one of the most innovative, responsive grant programs in breast cancer today. Our Affiliate is proud to have sent \$165,875.40 to the Organization for research in 2008-2009. In addition to funding research, the Affiliate funds non-duplicative, community-based breast health education and breast cancer screening and treatment projects for the medically underserved in Allendale, Bamberg, Barnwell, Beaufort, Berkeley, Charleston, Colleton, Dorchester, Georgetown, Hampton, Horry, Jasper, and Orangeburg counties. In 2009, we funded over \$674,000 to local community programs. Through our grants program, we were able to reach 218,914 women with breast health information and screening success.

Our grant cycle runs from April 1st, 2010, through March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2011. Eligible applications must be received in our office located at 9302 Medical Plaza Drive, Suite E, North Charleston, SC, 29406 no later than Noon on Friday, December 4<sup>th</sup>, 2009, for consideration. Announcements of funding will be made around February 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2010.
